Bobble - (Yoh and draw up a loop. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) 5 times in next st. Yoh and
draw through all 6 loops on hook.

Blankets for Baby Squares in the Corners Baby Blanket

From a center ring to a four-corner design, this beautifully shaded baby blanket is an easy project you can make. Plus, since it's made in squares, it's a great take-along project. With a lovely scalloped edge, this crocheted baby blanket will be a welcome gift.

Blanket measures 33½" x 33½".



MATERIALS:

- RED HEART® "Super Saver®" 5 oz. (141 g), 244 yd. (223 m) skeins: 4 skeins 995 Ocean
- Crochet hook, 4.5 mm [US G-7]
- Yarn needle

GAUGE: Each Square = 5½". CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain gauge.

INSTRUCTIONS: SQUARE (Make 36)

Ch 4, slip st in first ch to form ring. **Round 1:** Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), work 15 dc in ring, slip st in top of beginning ch – 16 dc.

Round 2: Ch 3, work 2 dc in same st, [ch 2, skip next dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, skip next dc, 3 dc in next dc] 3 times, ch 2, skip next dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, slip st in top of beginning ch – 8 ch-2 spaces.

Round 3: Ch 3, 5 dc in next dc, dc in next dc, [ch 2, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in next dc, 5 dc in next dc, dc in next dc, dc in next dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, slip st in top of beginning ch.

Round 4: Ch 3, dc in next 2 dc, 5 dc in next dc, dc in next 3 dc, [ch 2, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in next 3 dc, 5 dc in next dc, dc in next 3 dc] 3 times, ch 2, dc in next dc, ch 2, slip st in top of beginning ch.

Round 5: Ch 3, dc in next 4 dc, (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next dc for corner, dc in next 5 dc, [ch 2, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in next 5 dc, (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next dc for corner, dc in next 5 dc] 3 times, ch 2, dc in next dc, ch 2, slip st in top of beginning ch. Fasten off.

BLANKET

Arrange Squares into 6 rows of 6 Squares each. Whipstitch Squares together.

Border

Round 1: With right side facing, join yarn with a slip st in corner ch-1 space, ch 5 (counts as dc and ch 2), [dc in same ch-1 space, ch 2] twice, *skip next 3 dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, skip next 2 dc, dc in next dc, [ch 2, dc in next dc] twice, ch 2, skip 2 dc, dc in next dc, ch 2; repeat from * around working [dc, ch 2] 3 times in Border corner ch-1 space, slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch.

Round 2: Slip st in ch-2 space, ch 3, 3 dc in same ch-2 space, slip st in next dc, 4 dc in next ch-2 space, slip st in next ch-2 space, 4 dc in next ch-2 space, slip st in next ch-2 space, *[3 hdc in next dc, slip st in next ch-2 space, 4 dc in next ch-2 space] across to 3rd dc before first dc of next corner, 3 hdc in next dc, slip st in next ch-2 space, 4 dc in next ch-2 space, slip st in next ch-2 space, 4 dc in next ch-2 space, slip st in next dc, 4 dc in

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next ch-2 space, slip st in next ch-2 space, 4 dc in next ch-2 space; repeat from * around to last dc before last 3 ch-2 spaces on last side, 3 hdc in last dc, slip st in next ch-2 space, 4 dc in next ch-2 space, slip st in next ch-2 space, slip st in top of beginning ch.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

Poseys in the Squares Baby Blanket

By Michele Maks for Red Heart Yarns

Welcome a new baby with this intermediate level baby blanket. Create it now and have it ready to go for the next baby shower.

Blanket measures 38" x 38".



MATERIALS:

- RED HEART® "Baby Econo" 6 oz (170 g), 460 yd (421 m) skeins: 4 skeins 1047 Candy Print
- Crochet hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]
- Yarn needle

GAUGE: Square = 5". CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

INSTRUCTIONS:

BLANKET

Square (Make 49)

Ch 3, slip st in first st to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and

throughout), work 11 dc in ring, slip st in top of beginning ch - 12 sts.

Round 2: Ch 3, [slip st in front loop of next dc, ch 3] around, slip st in back loop in top of beginning ch of Round 1 - 12 loops.

Round 3: Ch 3, 2 dc in same space on Round 1, 3 dc in back loop of next dc on Round 1, ch 3, skip next st, *[3 dc in back loop of next dc] twice, ch 3, skip next st; repeat from * around, slip st in top of beginning ch - 4 ch-3 spaces.

Round 4: Slip st in next dc, ch 3, dc in next 3 dc, skip next dc, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in ch-3 space, *skip next dc, dc in next 4 dc, skip next dc, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in ch-3 space; repeat from * around; slip st in back loop of beginning ch.

Round 5: Ch 3, *dc in back loop of each dc to ch-3 space, dc in back loop of next ch, (dc, ch 1, dc) in back loop of next ch, dc in back loop of next ch; repeat from * to last ch-3 space, dc in back loop of next 3 dc, slip st in top of beginning ch.

Round 6: Slip st in front loop of next st on Round 4, ch 1, [slip st in next front loop, ch 1] around, slip st in first slip st.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Arrange Squares into 7 rows of 7 Squares each. Sew Squares together.

Edging

Round 1: With right side facing, join yarn in any st, ch 1, sc in each st around, working 3 sc in each Blanket corner ch-1 space, slip st in first sc.

Round 2: [Ch 2, slip st in next sc] around. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

The Coziest Crocheted Baby Blanket Ever

By Michele Wilcox for Red Heart Yarns

This cozy crocheted baby blanket is a great beginner project. Stitched in double crochet, the soft yarn in a multi-color blend works up quickly, thus making it perfect for a quick gift.

Blanket measures 30" x 32".



MATERIALS:

- RED HEART® "Buttercup™" 1.76 oz (50 g), 72 yd (66 m) balls: 8 balls 4273 Light Yellow Multi
- Crochet hook, 8mm [US L-11]
- Yarn needle

GAUGE: 8 double crochet = 4"; 5 rows = 4". CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

INSTRUCTIONS: BLANKET

Chain 61.

Row 1: Double crochet in 2nd chain from hook and each chain across – 60 double crochet. **Row 2:** Chain 2 (counts as double crochet), turn, working in front loops only, double crochet in each double crochet across.

Rows 3-41: Repeat Row 2.

Fasten off.

Two-Color Ripple Waves Baby Blanket

By Mary Jane Protus for Red Heart Yarns

This two-color ripple wave baby blanket is easy to crochet. Whether you choose to make it in blue and white, pink and white, yellow and green, or a brighter color combination, you'll love working this pattern.

Blanket measures 36" x 38".



MATERIALS:

- RED HEART® "Soft Yarn" 5 oz (140 g), 256 yd (234 m): 3 balls each 2541 Sky Blue A and 4600 White B.
- Crochet hook, 6 mm [US J-10]
- Yarn needle

GAUGE: 17 sts = 4" in pattern; 10 rows = 4". CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use and size hook to obtain the specified gauge.

NOTE: To Change Color in sc: Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, drop working color and pick up new color, pull new color through 2 loops on hook.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

shell: 5 dc in same st or space.

dc2tog (double crochet 2 together): [yo, insert hook in next st(sp), yo and pull through 2 loops on hook] twice, yo and pull through all 3 loops on hook (1 st dec).

dc3tog (double crochet 3 together): [yo, insert hook in next st(sp), yo and pull through 2 loops on hook] 3 times, yo and pull through all 4 loops on hook (2 sts dec).

Color Sequence

Work in the following color sequence throughout: *4 rows **A**, 2 rows **B**, 4 rows **A**, 4 rows **B**, 2 rows **A**, 4 rows **B**: repeat from * throughout.

INSTRUCTIONS:

BLANKET

With **A**, ch 163.

Row 1 (right side): Starting in 4th ch from hook, work dc2tog in next 2 ch, *ch 1, skip next ch, [dc in next ch, ch 1, skip next ch] twice, shell in next ch, ch 1, skip next ch, [dc in next ch, ch 1, skip 1 ch] twice**, dc2tog in next 2 ch, skip next ch, dc2tog in next 2 ch; repeat from * across to last 14 ch; repeat from * to ** once; end with dc3tog worked in last 3 ch; turn—10 shells.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in next ch-1 space, *[ch 1, skip next dc, sc in next ch-1 space or st] 7 times, ch 1, skip next 2 dc2tog, sc in next ch-1 space; repeat from * across; end with sc in top of beg ch-3; turn.


Row 3: Ch 3, dc2tog worked in next sc and next ch-1 space, *ch 1, [dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1] twice, shell in next ch-1 space, ch 1, [dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1] twice **, dc2tog worked in next ch-1 space and next sc, skip next ch-1 space, work dc2tog in next sc and next ch-1 space; repeat from * across 8 times; repeat from * to ** once; end with dc3tog worked in last ch-1 space and last 2 sc; turn.

Rows 4-89: Rep rows 2 and 3, working in color sequence as indicated above, ending with row 3 of pattern in color **A**. Do not fasten off. Weave in ends.

EDGING

Round 1: With right side facing, working with A, ch 1, *working across side edge of blanket, work sc, ch 1, skip space equal to ch-1*; repeat from * to * across side to bottom corner, work (sc, ch 1, sc) in corner st, working across opposite side of foundation ch, ch 1, **sc in space between next 2 dc, [ch 1, sc in ch-1 space] 3 times, skip next ch where shell is worked, [sc in next ch-1 space, ch 1] 3 times, sc between next 2 dc, ch 1, sc in next ch-1 space; repeat from ** across, ch 1, work (sc, ch 1, sc) in corner, repeat from * to * across side edge to next corner, work (sc, ch 1, sc) in corner st, ***[sc in ch-1 space, ch 1] 3 times, sc in next dc, ch 1, skip next dc, sc in next dc, ch 1, skip next dc, sc in next dc, fch 1, sc in next ch-1 sp] 3 times,

ch 1; repeat from *** across top edge; end with sc in top left-hand corner, ch 1; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

Crocheted Baby Comfort Blanket

By Katherine Eng for Red Heart Yarns

Here is an intermediate-level crocheted blanket for baby to play on while he's young and to carry around for comfort when he starts toddling. With all of the colors of Super Saver to choose from, you can coordinate your blanket with baby's nursery.

Blanket measures 36" x 36".



MATERIALS:

- Red Heart® "Super Saver®" 7 oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m) skeins: 3 skeins 381 Light Blue
- Crochet hook, 6 mm [US I-9]
- Yarn needle

Gauge: 3 clusters and 2 crossed dc = 4"; 6 rows = 4". CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Special Abbreviation

cluster: [Yo, insert hook in next st or space, yo, draw yarn through, yo, draw yarn through 2 loops on hook] 3 times in same st or space, yo, draw yarn through 4 loops on hook.

INSTRUCTIONS:

BLANKET

Ch 103.

Row 1: Working in back bottom loop of each ch, cluster in 6th ch from hook, *ch 1, skip next 2 ch, dc in next ch, dc in last skipped ch to right of last dc (crossed dc made), ch 1, skip 1 ch, cluster in next ch; repeat from * across ending with ch 1, skip 1 ch, dc in last ch, turn – 20 clusters and 19 crossed dc.

Row 2: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1 here and throughout), skip next ch-1 space, dc in next ch-1 space, dc in last skipped ch-1 space to the right (crossed dc made), *ch 1, cluster in space between next 2 dc of crossed dc, ch 1, crossed dc worked across next 2 ch-1 spaces; repeat from * across ending with ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of turning ch, turn.

Row 3: Ch 4, skip next ch-1 space, *cluster in space between next 2 dc of crossed dc, ch 1**, crossed dc worked across next 2 ch-1 spaces, ch 1; repeat from * across, ending last repeat at **, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of turning ch, turn.

Rows 4-49: Repeat rows 2-3, 23 times. At end of last row, do not turn. Do not fasten off.

Round 1 (right side): Ch 1, *2 sc in each row-end st across left side to next corner*, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner ch, working across bottom, sc in each ch-1 space and in each ch at base of a st to next corner, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner ch; repeat from * to * across right side to next corner, (sc, ch 2, sc) in 3rd ch of top right turning ch, working across top edge, sc in first ch-1 space, sc in each st and each ch-1 space across to next corner, (sc, ch 2, sc) in last dc, join with slip st in first sc – 100 sc across each side; 4 ch-2 corner spaces.

Round 2 (right side): Ch 1, sc in first sc, *[skip next 2 sc, 5 dc (shell made) in next sc, skip next 2 sc, sc in next sc] across to next corner, skip next 2 sc, 7 dc in corner ch-2 space, skip next sc, sc in next sc; repeat from * around, join with slip st in first sc, turn.

Round 3 (wrong side): Ch 4, skip next dc, *sc in next dc, ch 1, skip next dc, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next dc, ch 1, skip next dc, sc in next dc, ch 1, skip next dc, [dc in next sc, ch 2, sc in center dc of next shell, ch 2] across to next corner**, dc in next dc, ch 1; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at **, join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-4, turn. Round 4 (right side): Ch 3 (counts as dc), 4 dc in first st, sc in next sc, *[5 dc in next dc, sc in next sc] across to next corner, 2 dc in next sc, 5 dc in

Lingering over a Lullaby Blanket

This easy crocheted blanket with a ruffled edge will be treasured by any baby and Mom. This lovely print yarn is available in so many colors you'll find one you'll love.

Blanket measures 38" x 40".



MATERIALS:

- RED HEART® "Soft Baby Steps®" 3 oz (85 g), 153 yd (140 m) balls: 6 balls 9932 Puppy Print
- Crochet hook, 5.5mm [US I-9]
- Yarn needle

GAUGE: 3 Shells = $5\frac{1}{2}$ "; 8 rows = $4\frac{1}{2}$ " in pattern. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Special Abbreviations

Shell = (Dc, [ch 1, dc] 4 times) all in indicated st. **Picot** = Ch 3, slip st in 3rd ch from hook.

INSTRUCTIONS: BLANKET

Ch 110.

Row 1 (Right Side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, ch 3, skip next 3 ch, sc in next ch, * ch 2, skip next ch, sc in next ch, ch 3, skip next 3 ch, sc in next ch; repeat from * across, sc in last ch; turn – 18 ch-3 spaces.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), shell in next ch-3 space, * picot, shell in next ch-3 space; repeat from * across, skip next sc, dc in last st; turn – 18 shells.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in 2nd ch-1 space of next shell, ch 2, sc in next ch-1 space of same shell, * ch 3, sc in 2nd ch-1 space of next shell, ch 2, sc in next ch-1 space of same shell; repeat from * across, sc in last st; turn.

Row 4: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), (dc, ch 1) all in first st, picot, * shell in next ch-3 space, picot;repeat from * across, (dc, [ch 1, dc] twice) all in last st; turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in next ch-1 space, * ch 3, sc in 2nd ch-1 space of next shell, ch 2, sc in next ch-1 space of same shell; repeat from * across, ch 3, sc in last ch-1 space, sc in last st; turn. Repeat Rows 2-5 until blanket is 35ll, ending with Row 3.

Fasten off.

BORDER

Round 1 (Right Side): Join in any corner, ch 1, 2 sc in same st, [108 sc evenly across to next corner, 3 sc in next corner] 3 times; 108 sc evenly across, sc in first corner; join with a slip st to first st.

Round 2: Ch 1, sc in same st as join, ch 3, * skip next st, sc in next st, ch 3; repeat from * around; join.

Round 3: Slip st in next ch-3 space, ch 3 (counts as dc), 6 dc in same space, * [sc in next ch-3 space, ch 3] twice; sc in next ch-3 space, 7 dc in next ch-3 space; repeat from * around; sc in last ch-3 space, ch 3; join.

Round 4: Ch 3, dc in same st, [2 dc in next st] 6 times; * sc in next ch-3 space, ch 3, sc in next ch-3 space, [2 dc in next st] 7 times; repeat from * around; join.

Round 5: Ch 3, dc in same st, * [dc in next st, 2 dc in next st] 6 times; dc in next st, sc in next ch-3 space; repeat from * around; join. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

Easy One Ball Baby Blanket

By Marianne Forrestal for Red Heart Yarns

Crochet an easy baby blanket in your favorite color. The charming scalloped edge and delicate pattern are sure to please.

Blanket measures 39" x 32".



MATERIALS:

- RED HEART® "Baby Blankie™" 16 oz (453 g), 819 yd (749 m) balls: 1 ball 8590 Lavender
- Crochet hooks, 6.5mm [US K-10.5] and 4mm [US G-6]
- Yarn needle

GAUGE: 2 repeats = 4"; 7 rows = 4" in pattern with larger hook. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

INSTRUCTIONS:

BLANKET

With larger hook, ch 90.

Row 1 (Right Side): Dc in 6th ch from hook, dc in next 4 ch, ch 1, skip next ch, [dc in next 5 ch, ch 1, skip next ch] 13 times, dc in last ch; turn.

Row 2: Ch 3, dc in first dc, * ch 2, skip next 2 dc, sc in next dc, ch 2 **, 3 dc in next ch-1 space; repeat from * to last 2 sts, end at **; skip next ch, 2 dc in next ch; turn.

Row 3: Ch 3, dc in next dc, * dc in next ch-2 space, ch 1, dc in next ch-2 space **, dc in next 3 dc; repeat from * to last 2 sts, end at **; dc in next dc and top of ch-3; turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first dc, * ch 2, 3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 2, skip next 2 dc, sc in next dc; repeat from * across working last sc in top of ch-3; turn.
Row 5: Ch 4, * dc in ch-2 space, dc in next 3 dc, dc in next ch-2 space, ch 1; repeat from * to last st; dc in last sc; turn.

Rows 6-65: Repeat Rows 2-5 fifteen times. Do not turn at end of last row but pivot to work down next side.

BORDER:

Round 1: With right side still facing, work sc evenly around all 4 sides and work 3 sc in each corner; join with a slip st in first sc.

Round 2: * Ch 3, dc in same st, skip next 2 sc, slip st in next sc; repeat from * around adjusting as necessary at corners and end of round; join in first st of round. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Baby Block Crochet Blanket

By Bernat

The soft colors and delicate patterns make this a stand-out pattern. Little ones will love cuddling up to this crochet afghan pattern.

Blanket measures approx 32 x 40" [81 x 102 cm].



MATERIALS:

- Yarn: Bernat® Baby Coordinates (160 g/5.6 oz) Main Color (MC) (White) 2 balls, Contrast A (Yellow) 1 ball, Contrast B (Aqua) 1 ball
- Crochet Hook: Size 4 mm (U.S. G or 6) or size needed to obtain gauge

GAUGE: 1 square = 6" [15 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS: BLANKET

STAR SQUARE (make 15).

With MC. ch 33.

Foundation row: (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook. 1 dc in each ch to end of ch. 31 dc.

2nd row: Ch 3. 1 dc in each of next 6 dc. Ch 1. Miss next dc. 1 dc in each of next 15 dc. Ch 1. Miss next dc. 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Rows 1 and 2 of chart are complete. Beg with row 3, work chart to end of chart reading right side rows from right to left and wrong side rows from left to right, noting each row ends with ch 3. Turn. Omit turning ch at end of last row. Fasten off.

PLAIN SQUARE (make 8 with A; make 7 with B). Ch 33.

Foundation row: (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook. 1 dc in each ch to end of ch. 31 dc. Ch 3. Turn.

2nd row: Miss first dc. 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Ch 3. Turn. Rep last row 12 times more omitting turning ch at end of last row (14 rows total). Fasten off.

Following photo for placement, join squares into 5 strips, 6 squares long alternating Star Square with Plain Square A or B as shown.

EDGING:

1st rnd: With RS of work facing and MC, join yarn with sl st in any corner. Ch 1. Work 1 rnd sc evenly around blanket working 3 sc in corner sc. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

2nd rnd: Join A with sl st in any corner sc of previous rnd. Ch 3. 1 dc in each sc around working 3 dc in corner sc. Sl st to top of ch 3. Fasten off.

3rd rnd: Join MC with sl st in any corner dc of previous rnd. Ch 1. 1 sc in each dc around working 3 sc in corner dc. Sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

4th rnd: Join B with sl st in any corner sc of previous rnd. Ch 3. 1 dc in each sc around working 3 dc in corner sc. Sl st to top of ch 3. Fasten off.

Bumpy Baby Blanket

The soft texture of this blanket is what makes it stand out from the crowd. The color and feel will act as a comfort for even the fussiest kids.

Blanket measures approx 34 x 48 ins [86.5 x 122 cm].



MATERIALS:

- Bernat® Baby Coordinates (160 g/5.6 oz): 5 balls of #09131 (Blue Bon Bon)
- Crochet Hook: Size 5 mm (U.S. H or 8) or size needed to obtain gauge.

GAUGE: 16 dc and 8 rows = 4 ins [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS: BLANKET

Ch 126.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in next ch. Ch 1. Miss next ch. *1 sc in each of next 11 ch. Ch 1. Miss next ch. Rep from * to last 2 ch. 1 sc in each of last 2 ch. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in next sc. Ch 1. Miss next ch-1 sp. *1 dc in each of next 11 sc. Ch 1. Miss next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last 2 sc. 1 dc in each of last 2 sc. Ch 1. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 2 dc. Bobble in ch-1 sp 2 rows below. *1 sc in next dc. Ch 1. Miss next dc. 1 sc in each of next 7 dc. Ch 1. Miss next dc. 1 sc in next dc. Bobble in ch-1 sp 2 rows below. Rep from * to last 2 dc. 1 sc in next dc. 1 sc in top of turning ch. Turn.

4th row: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in each of next 3 sts. *Ch 1. Miss next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each of next 7 sts. Ch 1. Miss next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each of next 3 sts. Rep from * to last sc. 1 dc in last sc. Turn.

5th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 4 dc. *Bobble in ch-1 sp 2 rows below. 1 sc in next dc. Ch 1. Miss next dc. 1 sc in each of next 3 dc. Ch 1. Miss next dc. 1 sc in next dc. Bobble in ch-1 sp 2 rows below. 1 sc in each of next 3 dc. Rep from * to last st. 1 sc in top of turning ch. Turn.

6th row: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in each of next 5 sts. *Ch 1. Miss next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each of next 3 sts. Ch 1. Miss next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each of next 7 sts. Rep from * to last 10 sts. Ch 1. Miss next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each of next 3 sts. Ch 1. Miss next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each of next 6 sts. Turn.

7th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 6 dc. *Bobble in ch-1 sp 2 rows below. 1 sc in next dc. Ch 1. Miss next dc. 1 sc in next dc. Bobble in ch-1 sp 2 rows below. 1 sc in each of next 7 dc. Rep from * to last 11 sts. Bobble in ch-1 sp 2 rows below. 1 sc in next dc. Ch 1. Miss next dc. 1 sc in next dc. Bobble in ch-1 sp 2 rows below. 1 sc in each of next 5 dc. 1 sc in top of turning ch. Turn.

8th row: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in each of next 7 sts. Ch 1. Miss next ch-1 sp. *1 dc in each of next 11 sts. Ch 1. Miss next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last 8 sts. 1 dc in each of next 8 sts. Turn.

9th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 6 dc. *Ch 1. Miss next dc. 1 sc in next dc. Bobble in ch-1 sp 2 rows below. 1 sc in next dc. Ch 1. Miss next dc. 1 sc in each of next 7 dc. Rep from * to last 11 sts. Ch 1. Miss next dc. 1 sc in next dc. Bobble in ch-1 sp 2 rows below. 1 sc in next dc. Ch 1. Miss next dc. 1 sc in each of next 6 dc. Turn.

10th row: As 6th row.

11th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 4 dc. *Ch 1. Miss next dc. 1 sc in next dc. Bobble in ch-1 sp 2 rows below. 1 sc in each of next 3 dc. Bobble in ch-1 sp 2 rows below. 1 sc in next dc. Ch 1. Miss next dc. 1 sc in each of next 3 dc. Rep from * to last st. 1 sc in top of turning ch. Turn.

12th row: As 4th row.

13th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 2 dc. Ch 1. Miss next dc. 1 sc in next dc. *Bobble in ch-1 sp 2 rows below. 1 sc in each of next 7 dc. Bobble in ch-1 sp 2 rows below. 1 sc in next dc. Ch 1. Miss next dc. 1 sc in next dc. Rep from * to last st. 1 sc in top of turning ch. Turn.

Rep rows 2 to 13 for pat.

Cont in pat until work from beg measures approx 45 ins [114.5 cm], ending with row 3 of pat and omitting turning ch at end of last row. Fasten off.

EDGING:

Join yarn with sl st at top right corner of Blanket. Ch 3. Work 1 rnd dc around entire Blanket working 3 dc in corners. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. Work 2 more rnds of dc as before. Fasten off.

Chunky Lace Baby Blanket

This crocheted baby blanket is fun, colorful and whimsical. The slightly undone look gives it a fun edge. Make one for a little one with a wild streak.

Blanket measures approx 40 ins [101.5 cm] square.



MATERIALS:

- Bernat® Baby Coordinates Chunky (100 g / 3.5 oz): 9 balls of #99221 (Snuggly Sprite)
- Crochet Hook: size 6.5 mm (U.S. K or 10½) or size needed to obtain gauge.

GAUGE: 12 hdc and 10 rows = 4 ins [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS:

BLANKET

Note: Ch 2 at beg of row does not count as hdc.

Ch 13.

1st row: (RS). 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each of next 10 ch. Turn. 11 hdc.

2nd to 7th rows: Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc to end

2nd to 7th rows: Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.

**8th row: Ch 14. 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each of next 10 ch. Ch 1. Miss next ch. *1 hdc in next hdc. Ch 1. Miss next st. Rep from * to last hdc. 1 hdc in last hdc. Turn.

9th row: Ch 14. 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each of next 10 ch. Ch 1. Miss next ch. *1 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Miss last ch-1 sp. 1 hdc in each of last 11 hdc. Turn.

10th to 15th rows: Ch 2. *1 hdc in each of next 11 hdc. Ch 1. Miss next ch-1 sp. Rep from *, ending with 1 hdc in each of last 11 hdc.** 8th to 15th rows form Lace Pat. Rep from ** to ** 6 times more.

***Next 2 rows: Pat to last 12 sts. Turn. Leave rem sts unworked.

Work 6 rows even in pat.***

Rep from *** to *** until there are 11 sts.

Work 6 rows even in pat. Fasten off.
